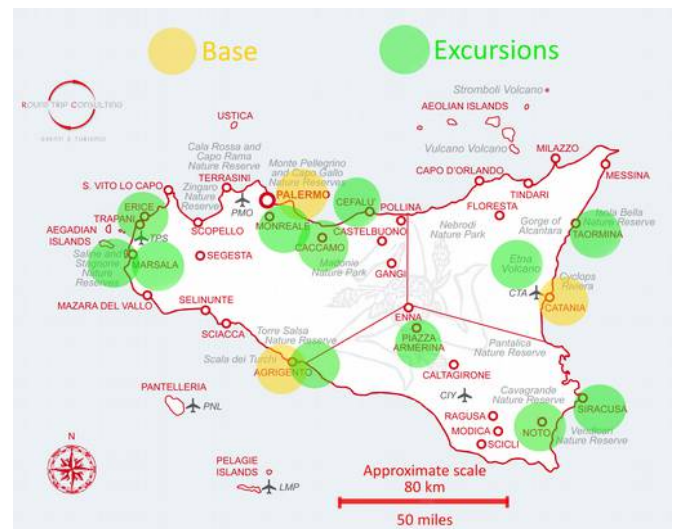

Your bases: **Palermo**, located on the Northern coast, boasts more than 2700 years of history and a great cultural diversity; **Agrigento**, the site of the ancient Greek city of Akragas, one of the leading cities of Magna Grecia; **Catania**, the second city of Sicily which lies beneath Mt. Etna, is located in strategic position on the Ionian coast.

Both are the perfect base points to explore the island and reach the most important artistic, archaeological, cultural and natural Sicilian sites in the quickest and easiest ways possible.

Detailed 8 days - 7 nights itinerary

Day 1 – PALERMO

Upon arrival in Sicily our friendly representatives will greet you at the Falcone e Borsellino Airport (Palermo, PMO). Have a direct transfer to your 4-star hotel in the city-center of Palermo, in the Northern coast of Sicily.

The hotel is close to the Politeama theater and Via Libertà, the most elegant fashion street in Palermo, rich in prestigious retailers.

Check-in at the hotel and spend your time at leisure(*).

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Palermo.

(*) On request and according to the arrival time, it is possible to experience one or more of the following activities in Palermo:

- Enjoy a traditional puppet show in the heart of Palermo (it belongs to UNESCO cultural heritage list) and be mesmerized by traditional story of Norman kings in Sicily, of Charlemagne and his knights and more.
- Visit the wonderful opera house in Palermo, Massimo Theatre (built in late 19th century and featured in the last scenes of Godfather III). Enjoy a nightly performance and experience the amazing acoustic of the theater. Enjoy a tour of Palermo by night!
- Enjoy a shopping walk in Via Libertà, the most elegant fashion street in Palermo, rich in prestigious retailers (Personal shoppers provided on request).
- Reach the neighboring small borough of Mondello, one of most popular tourist place in Italy, with a gorgeous sand beach.
- Visit Mt. Pellegrino, the most famous mountain in Palermo. During his “Italian Journey”, Goethe described it as “the most beautiful promontory in the world”. Visit the church of Santa Rosalia inside a stunning cave and then start a relaxing trail to a panoramic point over the northern coastline.



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Day 2: PALERMO AND MONREALE - The Unesco Arab-Norman circuit and one of the most important historic centres in Europe.

After breakfast meet your English speaking tourist guide and move to **Monreale** (10 km from Palermo). Visit the amazing Norman Cathedral (one of the finest example of sacred architecture in the world) and the cloister built by the Benedictines during the 12nd century.

Then return to **Palermo** and start a guided walking tour through the magnificent historic city-center, full of heritage, art and culture: enjoy the Arab-Norman circuit (included in the **Unesco World Heritage list** in 2015) with the Normans Palace, the Palatine Chapel and the Cathedral.

Experience a true immersion in Palermo and visit Ballarò, a typical historic outdoor market where you will be surrounded by different colors, amazing scents and funny vendors singing or shouting out their offerings. Have your lunch at a great restaurant in the heart of Palermo.

Our tips for lunch: enjoy the traditional Sicilian cuisine and some typical Sicilian street food (Palermo is ranked 5th among the world's best cities for quality of street food!). After a complete meal, enjoy the Cannolo, the world famous Sicilian dessert. After the lunch resume your tour and visit other beautiful monuments, buildings and churches from the Arabian-Norman period to the Spanish period (12nd - 18th Century) such as "4 Canti", Piazza Pretoria, Martorana. At the end take a look at the stunning theaters from the late 19th Century (Massimo and Politeama).

Spend your time at leisure.

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Palermo.



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Day 3: CACCAMO AND CEFALÙ - The Middle Ages overlook a pristine sea.

After breakfast meet your English speaking driver and move to **Caccamo**, 46 km far from Palermo.

Get out from the classic tourist patterns and breathe the atmosphere of a medieval town.

With an English speaking tourist guide, enjoy a tour of the medieval castle of Caccamo.

The “unconquered fortress”, built by Normans directly on a rocky outcrop about 1000 years ago, is the largest in the island and has a breathtaking view.

Imagine just that you are thrown in the Middle Ages and discover the intrigues of the castle.

In the afternoon you will discover **Cefalù**: spend some time relaxing on its beautiful beach or walking through the narrow streets of the medieval center.

Our tips for lunch: have a lunch at a typical restaurant beside the Castle of Caccamo or at a sea restaurant in Cefalù and enjoy some of the most popular Sicilian dishes.

Our recommendation in Cefalù: enjoy the “granita”, a typical Sicilian ice cream, in front of the Norman Cathedral of Cefalù, built in 1131.

Return to your hotel in the evening. Spend your time at leisure.

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Palermo.



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Day 4: ERICE AND MARSALA - Wine and salt on the Phoenicians route, the mystery of the Middle Ages and the charm of a magnificent view.

After breakfast meet your English speaking driver and move to **Erice**, a beautiful medieval town "suspended in time" at 750 meters above the sea level. The town was founded by the Trojan exiles in the 3rd century BC and is located at the top of a mountain. Experience its amazing historic center, walking through the narrow streets and enjoying the breathtaking view of the Aegadian Islands. Take a look to the Norman castle and the numerous towers, churches and old houses built on the rock.

Move to **Marsala**, in the westernmost point of Sicily and after a short visit enjoy your lunch.

Our tips for the lunch: taste a special "cous cous", an Arabic culinary specialty, now great expression of Sicilian cuisine. Marsala is also famous for the namesake fortified wine and it's a stopover for all the wine lovers; have a guided tour in an important historic winery (almost 200 years old) and experience a wine tasting there (enjoy the finest wines accompanied by Sicilian delicacies).

Reach **Agrigento** (in the south of Sicily) in the late evening. The town is renowned as the site of the ancient Greek city of Akragas, one of the leading cities of Magna Grecia (the Italian areas colonized by Greek from the 5th century BC). Check-in at your hotel and spend your time at leisure.

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Agrigento.



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Day 5: AGRIGENTO AND PIAZZA ARMERINA - The Valley of the Temples and the Villa Romana del Casale.

After breakfast meet your English speaking guide and move to the “**Valley of the Temples**”, a splendid archaeological park included in the Unesco Heritage Site list in 1997. During a guided visit admire the magnificent temples dedicated to the Greek gods, such as the Temple of Concordia, one of the best examples of Doric art in the world.

After a stop for lunch, move to **Piazza Armerina** to discover the world's finest mosaics from the Roman period! Piazza Armerina, almost in the center of Sicily, is a nice small town famous in the world for the Archaeological Park which includes the **Villa Romana del Casale**. The Roman Villa (from the 4th century) includes many magnificent mosaics and representations of classical mythology, in excellent condition.

Depart to **Catania**, the second city of Sicily which lies beneath Mt. Etna and check-in at your hotel located in the heart of the city.

Spend your time at leisure.

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Catania.



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Day 6: TAORMINA AND MT. ETNA - The beauty and the beast!

Have your breakfast at your hotel and meet your English speaking driver.

Depart to **Mt. Etna** and discover the tallest active volcano in Europe (3.329 m – 10.922 ft). It was added to the list of Unesco World Heritage Sites in June 2013. Enjoy a drive to Silvestri Craters in the south of the volcano or combine an adventure tour by 4wd vehicles with a pleasant walk to admire the signs of last eruptions in the north area.

Reach a **winery** at the slopes of Mt. Etna, surrounded by vineyards and fascinating natural environment.

Experience the typical Etna wines and have a lunch with some Sicilian delicacies.

In the afternoon visit the historic center of **Taormina**. It combines the natural beauty with the artistic and archaeological heritage: in addition to the nice cathedral and the streets of the old town, Taormina is famous for its ancient theatre (built by the Greeks around the second century BC; it holds outdoor shows and concerts).

Spend your time at leisure and shopping in Corso Umberto, with its boutiques, handicraft shops and its poetic atmosphere, steeped with history, traditions and literature.

Time for leisure and dinner.

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Catania.



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Day 7: SYRACUSE AND NOTO – The most beautiful city of Magna Grecia and the heart of Baroque.

Have your breakfast at your hotel and meet your English speaking driver. Then have a direct transfer to **Noto**, one of the greatest expressions of Sicilian Baroque.

The urban fabric of this town retains a rich and varied record of its past including buildings, stairways and plazas from the 18th century.

Our tip for lunch: enjoy a great lunch at a traditional Sicilian cuisine restaurant in the city-center of Noto.

After lunch move to **Syracuse**, “The most beautiful city of Magna Grecia”, in the opinion of Cicero (Syracuse was founded by ancient Greek Corinthians, it is almost 2700 years old and it was included in the Unesco Heritage Site list in 2005). Visit the archaeological park of Syracuse with the Greek theatre (the largest and the best preserved in the entire Hellenic world), the Ear of Dionysius (famous for the peculiar sound effect) and the Roman amphitheatre.

Then move to **Ortigia**, the heart of the ancient Syracuse. Admire the remains of Greek civilization, first of all the temple of Apollo, the oldest one in Sicily and the temple of Athena, incorporated in the cathedral, that is also the first Christian church in Europe. During the walk, take a look at churches, palaces and fountains from the medieval and last centuries.

Return to your hotel in Catania and spend your time at leisure.

Overnight: 4-star hotel in Catania.



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Day 8: CATANIA – DEPARTURE - The elephant at the shadow of Mt. Etna!

Have your breakfast at your hotel, check-out, and meet your English speaking tourist guide.

During a pleasant half-day guided walking tour you can visit the Baroque city center of **Catania** (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), famous for the Roman amphitheater, the historical churches, the Ursino Castle, the Benedictine Monastery of “San Nicolò” and the Piazza Duomo with the famous elephant (symbol of the city).

Our tips: enjoy a typical Sicilian food experience at Piscarià, an authentic outdoor fish market where you will be seduced by amazing colors and flavours.

According your departure time meet your English speaking driver and have a private transfer to the **Fontanarossa Airport** (Catania, CTA).



Target: this is a private and escorted tour of Sicily which can be arranged for individual customers (small groups from 2 persons). It gives you the chance to discover the Sicilian cultural heritage, visit the most stunning places of the island and enjoy its food and wine excellencies.

Transfers: the package always includes private transfers by comfortable cars or middle size vans.

Staff: the package includes English speaking drivers during the whole tour (other languages on request) and qualified English speaking guides during the visit of Palermo, Monreale, the Valley of the Temples and Catania (other guided visit such as Syracuse or Taormina are on request).

Accommodations: the package include a stay at 4 stars hotels (accommodation in Standard Double Room: accommodation in Deluxe or Suite on request) in the city-center of Palermo and Catania (these solutions give you the chance to enjoy shopping, restaurants and the night life: everything is walking distance to the hotel) and a stay at a 4 stars hotel in the area of the Valley of the Temples near Agrigento. On request, we can provide you with 5 stars resorts and agrirelais near the national parks or close to the sea.

Meals and tastings: this package include 1 wine tastings at a historic winery in Marsala and 1 wine tasting with lunch at a winery at the slopes of Mt. Etna. Other lunches are not included but our drivers will suggest you the best restaurants where you can find out the most authentic Sicilian cuisine! On request we can include lunches in the package.

Concerning to the dinners, this package include 1 dinner in Agrigento. Since many great restaurants are near your hotels in Palermo and Catania (walking distance) and we want you to be free to decide how to spend your nights, packages usually do not include dinners. On request we can include other dinners in the package.

Philosophy and customization of the tour: our itineraries help you to relax and optimize your time in Sicily. Palermo and Catania are the perfect base points to explore the Island.

You don't have to change hotel everyday (no need to pack and unpack your luggages every time) because distances between towns and the most important Sicilian sites are short.

You can personalize this tour according your needs (you can add places to visit or extend the duration of your tour).

On request we can provide you with transfers from/to other Sicilian airports (different from the scheduled ones). According to your flights a reverse itinerary is available.

Price: the package has a cost of €1924,00 per person for a group of 2 persons and €1573,00 per person for a group of 4 person. Taxes are included. The fee do not include extra costs at the hotel (minibar, telephone, etc), entrance tickets (to the archaeological sites, museums, etc), city taxes and airfare tickets. Supplement for half board treatment (7 lunches included) from € 210,00 per person.

For larger groups, the final price quote will be established in accordance with the services chosen and the number of participants.

Key Facts – Sicily

Sicily is **the largest Italian region**, a “little continent” rich in art, culture, archaeology, history (a list of **20 Unesco World Heritage Sites**), breathtaking sceneries, (**4 Regional Parks, 77 Nature Reserves and 3 volcanoes**), crystal clear waters, quiet medieval towns, refined cuisine, great wines, important literary traditions, myths and legends.

Sicily is a **safe and exclusive destination** just few hours by plane from anywhere in Europe. Thanks to its sceneries, heritage and mild climate, it attracts **5 millions annual tourists** from all over the world.

HISTORY OF SICILY

Sicily has been inhabited since the Paleolithic and Mesolithic. It had been part of the **Ancient Greece**, and then it was invaded and ruled by many different conquerors, such as Romans, Arabs, Normans, Swabians, Spanish and French. Those populations, of course, brought in the island their arts, science, culture and architecture.

GEOGRAPHY

Sicily has a roughly triangular shape, which earned it the name of **Trinacria** (in Greek “three promontories”).

Sicily is in the middle of **Mediterranean Sea** and it is the **largest** of its islands. Sicily's interior offers a wide variety of landscapes: mountains, hills, gorges and two fertile large plains around Catania and Palermo.



Mount Etna (10900ft/3348 meters) is the largest and the tallest active volcano in Europe. It is also the tallest mountain in Sicily.

Palermo is the capital (population: 700.000). Sicilian population is 5.000.000. Sicily has got **6 airports** to provide easy access to the various areas of the island; they are well served by international, national and low cost airlines. A direct flight connects New York City to Palermo.
